



UNDER 8'S SMALL GRANT SCHEME 2011-2012 - CRITERIA

- **The organisation must not be registered with CSSIW.**
- Grants will be provided to help establish, expand or develop services for children. Eligible provision could include a parent and toddler group, family centre, home-visiting-scheme, etc.
- The grant should be in the form of one-off minor capital or revenue grants, e.g. for equipment or materials, structural or conversion work, training / publications, toys / play equipment and pilot schemes.
- The maximum grant available is £200.
- A record will be kept of each grant made and groups will be required to produce a report on the project, how money has been spent and how the grant has been of benefit to the group or the establishment of the new service. Failure to submit a report will jeopardise future applications.
- Equipment purchased ultimately remains the property of the Carmarthen County Council – if the group closes, the Children's Partnership must be informed as a refund of the grant or the return of equipment may be required.
- You will also need to include the following with your completed application:
 - **The organisation's annual accounts**
 - **A bank statement (less than 3 months old)**
 - **Written estimates/quotations**

Any applications that fail to provide any of the above (or do not give a legitimate reason for not doing so) may not be considered for funding.
